#### Advent 2025

The season of Advent is our way of preparing for the birth of Jesus and is filled with God's miracles focused on four weeks before Christmas with Hope, Peace, Joy and Love.

The season of Advent also is contextualized by the future event of the second coming of Jesus Christ (Acts 7: 52).

It is easy to get our cast of characters mixed up like I did at our last confirmation class with John the Baptist and John the Apostle. My take away from that experience is that of the miracle birth of John the Baptist includes the story of the Word that became flesh and dwelt among us in his Prolog. So, we have one John writing about the other John.

Again, we have miracles all around us and the story of the birth of John the Baptist is a miracle birth story as well. So, we read that Jesus and John the Baptist were related through their mothers. Mary and Eliabeth were cousins. They were both pregnant at the same time and there is a famous passage in the Bible that connects them during that time of pregnancy and anticipation of the births of their two sons (Read Luke 1:44).

The miracle of the birth of John the Baptist is captured in scripture when the Angel Gaberial appeared to Eliabeth and her husband Zachariah. Elizabeth and Zacariah where too old to conceive a child but God granted them a miracle of fertility. Later John Baptizes Jesus (Luke 1:13).

I would offer this as a reflection for this Advent and Christmas, that we see the full story of God's miracles in the Holy Season and claim them as a part of our own salvation and personal miracles God has touched us with through Jesus the Christ.
